**Beginner:** Has done little sewing, has not used a rotary cutter or used one only a little and has a great desire to learn it all!

**Confident Beginner:** Knows rotary cutting techniques, is comfortable with his/her sewing machine (threading, using, etc.), can read a pattern and has quilting and sewing experience.

**Intermediate:** Has quilted and sewn a lot, desires to do more complicated quilting projects and is ready for a challenge.

## **60 Table runner** (confident beginner)

Ever looked at a wonderful stripe, loved it but felt a stab of fear over how to use it? Choose a stripe, a 60° triangle ruler and try out this pattern. You'll look at stripes differently!

## **Hourglass** (confident beginner)

## **OH-MI Shop Hop**

After having major snow events the last 2 years during the OH-MI Shop Hop, we have decided to move the event to late March in hopes that the weather and the roads will be better. ## “Rock star”

We've been really excited with the collection of Stonehenge Fabrics from Northcott. There is a huge variety of colors with the natural texture of stone. We'll be starting a new Block of the Month in January using the Stonehenge collection. All of the blocks will be Sawtooth Stars with different 6 inch blocks in the center. The colors will be different every month. You will receive the finish pattern with the last month's kit. The first month's kit is \$8; bring the block back finished anytime during the next month and receive that month's block for \$6. If you don't bring in the finished block your next kit will be \$8. This will give you a little incentive to finish your block each month! Call to sign up so we have some idea how many kits to make. Kits will be available starting Tuesday, January 3<sup>rd</sup>.



## SEASONAL MINI

We've had so much fun doing the Monthly Minis from Patch Abilities that we have decided to do another series from that company. This time the quilts are seasonal—three for each season. We'll start with the spring ones so that the quilts can be finished and enjoyed in the appropriate season. The quilts finish to 6" x 11 1/2" so that they will fit a 6" hanger or the Triple Table Stand from Ackfeld Manufacturing. Each kit will have the fabric for the top and the binding, as well as any perle cotton and buttons needed for embellishment. Many of the quilts have handmade buttons from Just Another Button Company. The background and binding for all three quilts for each season will match so that the quilts will look great hanging together. Hangers will be available for purchase but will not be included with the kits so that you can choose the type of hanger that will work best for you. The cost each month is \$19. To sign up you'll simply pay for the first month's kit, which can be done in person or by phone with a credit card. If you sign up for the whole series you will receive a free 13<sup>th</sup> pattern with your last kit. There will be a few extra kits available each month for purchase without doing the entire series.

## Ginger Rose

“Ginger Rose” is a wonderful sampler quilt from Andover Fabrics that will be starting in the next few months. This is a beautiful collection in gold, green, black and red. There is no exact start date yet as the fabric has been delayed because of Hurricane Irene (Andover lost their warehouse in New Jersey). Watch for details and the sample soon.

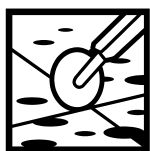
